Stay-n-Play!

Who Can Use the Stay-N-Play Program?

- ANY Parent/grandparent who needs a short break, to run a quick errand, go to an appointment, etc.
- ANY child age 4 months-6 years old



How Do I Register My Child for Stay-N-Play?

- Request an Enrollment Packet. We can Mail a Packet to you or you can stop to Pick up a Packet.
- Set up a Program Visit date to Meet the Care Staff, Review Packet and Program Guidelines.

How Does the Drop-In Work?

Once you have completed your enrollment information and have had your visit...

Reserve Your Spot: Call 315-536-1134 to see if there is a spot available on the day you'd like to bring your child! Spots are limited! You can call the day of and up to 30 days in advance to reserve spot.

Drop Off Your Child: Use our Downstairs Children's Room Entrance (Driveway to Parking area behind CFR Building during program hours 1pm - 3:30pm).

Enjoy Time To Do What You Need!

Pick Up Your Child: Children must be picked up by 3:30pm.

Late pick-ups will jeopardize future use of Stay-N-Play and program funding.

Stay-N-Play is designed for short term, irregular child care needs. It is not intended for use as child care for working parents or court business purposes. For care during court related business please contact the Children's Center at Yates County Courthouse (315-531-3438).
